The culture is largely due to the Team Managers, coaches, playing and parent groups. A big focus next year will be to strengthen the future of our mods with an increased focus on our Auskickers. Thankyou Kylie, Jas, Luke and Stephen for all your hard work and dedication to the kids and making it a fun and exciting learning experience for them all.

7/8 and 11/12 girls had increased numbers on last year which is reflection on the team cultures and the hard work by Jasmine, Tanya, Charlie and Jason. Significant increase in both revenue streams coupled with some hard work in attaining grants, has enabled us to increase our income by 93%. We are utilising social media platforms to demonstrate our community spirit, family culture along with our individual and collective successes. Our Instagram posts were noticed by the AFL and ultimately resulted in a banner of one of our posts travelling the country with the Premiership Cup.



Reconciliation has been a priority in 2021, with the setting up of an Indigenous Focus group to help facilitate a RAP. We have commenced with a couple of meetings to identify what we can do as a club to expediate reconciliation within the broader community. We have implemented some signage in as a quick and simple recognition; however, we will continue to work towards bringing in language and to further educate members of culture and country. In the new year the focus group will be looking towards our members to help guide us with initiatives to further demonstrate our commitment.

From a governance perspective, over the past year we have been looking into our by-laws. We will be publishing the club by-laws shortly. The club by-laws will provide more constituency in decision making, ultimately making decisions more transparent and defining club culture. Additional to the by-laws, we will be reviewing the Club Constitution.
